Esteem will be a guest speaker at 4PM to introduce a product that could be used to provide Health instruction. This presentation will be given by Tonya Waite. She will inform us about the curriculum for 5th - 12th graders that her company provides and how it addresses the TEA requirements in public schools.

The committee was informed that these bills will drive the "what" that will be instructed, the committee will have a say in the "how" this will be provided to the students of Bowie ISD.

The committee was shown a spreadsheet that was produced by Rebecca Pickett to show a list of possible curriculums that are available for adoption. The adoption committee will continue to use demo accounts and review the options and present back at our next meeting with their preferred resource for their particular age group. Principals will also be a part of this discussion to assure the resource matches the implementation on campus.

Tonya Waite presented the Esteem curriculum option.

- There are 10 core topics covered.
- Students have their own workbook that has a component that can be taken home for at-home discussions as well. (no copies are allowed)
- 10 Lessons are covered.
- Parent worksheets may be posted for parents to download and use with their students.
- Educational reminders are built into the program. (bookmarks, visuals, etc)
- Referred to many points of research.







- There is a document that places the page number from the packet where the TEKS is covered.
- This plan includes 10 lessons in which each may be presented in approximately 45-90 min blocks.

Discussions were good with the committee about the importance of these topics and how the topics in the Health TEKS address many of the hot topics that SHAC brought up in the 1st quarter meeting as district concerns. BISD students reported that the topics weren't covered in the secondary level after 6th grade health unless you took a Health Science Elective in 8th grade. Community parent involvement was discussed as a necessary part of this process. The committee liked the idea of having experts like the nurse, SRO, and community members help teach some of the topics. April Word discussed the need for transparency in the curriculum for parents to support. She stated that if her children will being taught these critical life lessons, she would want to know the perspective and content. Aaron Degler discussed the possibility of having outside speakers come in to cover many of the topics.

Nominations were made for Secretary of SHAC were made for Jeneanne Fleming. Motion made by Aaron Degler to name Jeneanne Fleming as Secretary of SHAC. A Second was made by Wayne Walker. The committee accepted the nomination and Jeneanne Fleming will be the secretary for SHAC.

The 3rd quarter meeting for SHAC will need to be prior to the April Board meeting where we will have the SHAC committee's recommendation for the Health Adoptions. The committee said the 3:45 time and Tuesdays are great. Notification 3 weeks in advance is plenty of time for everyone. Mrs. Farris will send it out like in prior meetings.
