Meeting Adjourned at 3:48 by Mrs. Farris.

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

The Health Resources were reviewed and Mrs. Farris presented the draft form on the new 2022 Health TEKS. Print in red is the new additions and revisions.

Elementary compared the Catch program and Quaver.

Lori Cage shared her opinions on Quaver and how it can be utilized at the BES in PE. Mrs. Cage told about the ease of use with her Lu System in the gym and that she has already used a few lessons in Quaver and the students liked the visual and upbeat lesson.

William Pickett shared his opinion on Quaver, benefits, and ease of the program. He also shared how 2 TEKS on sexual health were presented in the Quaver lesson.

Mrs. Farris let the committee know that they would be putting a Health tab under curriculum on the website to let parents know what will be discussed. She spoke of the OPT for sexual health in grades 4-12 and using the online registration process. She also let the committee know that we listened to your recommendation for experts so we will be training SROs, Nurse, Counselors, and Teachers for the 10 ESTEEM lessons. All resources that were looked out are conservative in nature and only address the TEKS with no added opinions.

Secondary compared McGraw Hill and ESTEEM.

Rebecca Goodman from Bowie Junior High explained the plan for teaching 10 lessons from ESTEEM in 6th grade PE and then 7th and 8th BIM and Ag classes. She explained the conservativeness of the program and how the content matches the TEKS.

Lee Ann Farris explained the high school will teach the ESTEEM program in 10th grade World History class

Nearpod is another resource the district has purchased to supplement teacher lessons based on topics and TEKS. They have Social and Emotional Lessons embedded in the program that addresses the Health TEKS and are used K-12 to supplement instruction

Ashley Atkins spoke about last year's Back to School Bash and the improvements she has for this year. The SHAC committee helped brainstorm ideas for vaccines and more community involvement.



- There was a discussion about how to deliver supplies to the campus vs picking them up at the event.
- Information on Counseling services would be an improvement that was discussed. Helem Farabee was suggested by Monica Delao.
- Using the fire station for free hot dogs vs BBQ food truck.
- Once Upon a Party Characters for Pictures
- Dodge Ball or Cornhole Fundraiser - Speak to the Class of 2023 to see if they want to sponsor and earn the money.
- Online registration help was really helpful and well-received last year.
- Community Service hours for NHS students to get additional help.

There was a motion for the ESTEEM curriculum for secondary and the Quaver curriculum for Elementary to be the recommendation by the SHAC committee to the Bowie ISD community by Lori Cage and was seconded by Sara Brinson.

The next meeting time was not designated, but the committee agreed that the 2-3 week advance notice that Mrs. Farris was doing was sufficient.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:04 PM.
